

METHODOLOGY: PEER REGION SELECTION

MadREP evaluated 14 potential peer regions against 13 economic metrics (all listed below), as well as a collection of rankings and accolades. Each of the metrics were reviewed and compared with the performance of the Madison Region, the state, or MSA, depending on data availability. The final selection of peer regions was based on the relative overall performance (based on the metrics considered) of each potential peer region, as well as a consideration for geographical diversity of the final regions selected.
